### Names of Indian Nobel Prize laureates-01

#### Rabindranath Tagore — Nobel Prize 1913

- Rabindranath Tagore received the **Nobel Prize in Literature in 1913**.
- He was the **first Asian to receive a Nobel Prize**.
- He received the prize mainly for his celebrated work **Gitanjali**.
- He wrote the **Indian National Anthem, "Jana Gana Mana."**
- He founded **Visva-Bharati University at Santiniketan**.

#### C. V. Raman — Nobel Prize 1930

- Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman** received the **Nobel Prize in Physics in 1930**.
- He was awarded the prize for his work on the **scattering of light**.
- His major discovery is known as the **Raman Effect**.
- National Science Day** is observed in India on **28 February** to commemorate the discovery of the Raman Effect.
- He was the **first Indian scientist to receive a Nobel Prize**.

#### Har Gobind Khorana — Nobel Prize 1968

- Har Gobind Khorana received the **Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine in 1968**.
- He was awarded for his work on the **interpretation of the genetic code**.
- His research helped explain the **role of the genetic code in protein synthesis**.
- He shared the Nobel Prize with **Robert W. Holley and Marshall W. Nirenberg**.
- He was born in **Raipur, Multan, British India** (now in Pakistan).

#### Mother Teresa — Nobel Peace Prize 1979

- Mother Teresa received the **Nobel Peace Prize in 1979**.
- She was honoured for her work in **helping suffering and disadvantaged people**.
- Her original name was **Agnes Gonxha Bojaxhiu**.
- She founded the **Missionaries of Charity** in India.
- She was awarded the **Bharat Ratna in 1980**.

#### Subrahmanyan Chandrasekhar — Nobel Prize 1983

- Subrahmanyan Chandrasekhar received the **Nobel Prize in Physics in 1983**.
- He was honoured for his theoretical studies of **the physical processes important to the structure and evolution of stars**.
- The famous **Chandrasekhar Limit** is named after him.
- The Chandrasekhar Limit is related to the **maximum mass of a stable white dwarf star**.
- He shared the Nobel Prize with **William A. Fowler**.

### Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)

### Why in News?

The **Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)** has developed **India's first indigenous vaccine against African Swine Fever (ASF)**, marking a significant milestone in strengthening the country's livestock health and biosecurity.

#### Expository: -

##### Establishment and History-

- The **Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)** was established on **16 July 1929** as a **registered society** under the **Societies Registration Act, 1860**.
- It was formally established as the **Imperial Council of Agricultural Research**.
- The **Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)** was first reorganized in **1965**.

##### Nature and Administrative Control-

- ICAR is an **autonomous organisation** under the **Department of Agricultural Research and Education (DARE)**.
- It functions under the **Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India**.

##### Headquarters and Institutions-

- The **headquarters of ICAR** is located in **New Delhi**.
- There are a total of **101 ICAR institutes** and **71 agricultural universities**.

##### Farmers Innovation Fund-

- The **Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)** will start a **Farmers Innovation Fund**.

##### National Farmers Day (Kisan Diwas)-

- Kisan Diwas or National Farmers Day** is observed across the country on **23 December**.
- The day is celebrated to commemorate the **birth anniversary of Chaudhary Charan Singh**, the former Prime Minister of India.

##### Norman E. Borlaug and Green Revolution-

- Dr. Norman E. Borlaug** won the **Nobel Peace Prize in 1970** for his contribution to global agriculture.

- He is widely known as the **Father of the Green Revolution**.

##### World Food Prize-

- The **World Food Prize** is also known as the **"Nobel Prize for Food and Agriculture."**
- Dr. Rattan Lal** was declared the winner of the **World Food Prize 2020**.
- Dr. M. S. Swaminathan**, known as the **Father of India's Green Revolution**, was the **first recipient of this award in 1987**.

##### World Food Day-

- World Food Day** is observed annually on **16 October**.
- It aims to address the problem of **global hunger**.
- It is associated with **SDG 2 – Zero Hunger**.

##### Indigenous African Swine Fever Vaccine-

- ICAR** has developed an **indigenous vaccine for African Swine Fever (ASF)**, reducing dependence on imported technologies and strengthening India's preparedness against the disease.

##### African Swine Fever (ASF)-

- African Swine Fever is a **highly contagious viral disease** that affects **domestic and wild pigs**.
- The causative agent is the **African Swine Fever Virus (ASFV)**, which belongs to the **Asfarviridae family**.

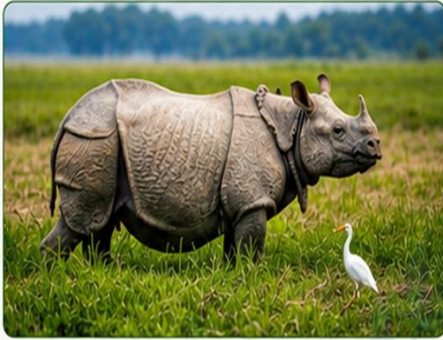

## MAJOR NATIONAL PARKS OF INDIA

### KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK



Declared as National Park: **1974**



State: **Assam**



History:

- **1905** – Declared as Reserved Forest
- **1908** – Made a Game Sanctuary
- **1950** – Granted Wildlife Sanctuary status
- **1974** – Declared as National Park



Key Features:

- Kaziranga National Park, located in Assam, is the largest habitat of the One-horned Rhinoceros in India.
- It was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1985.
- The park is known for its extensive grasslands and forests, which are home to a rich variety of wildlife including elephants, tigers and swamp deer.
- It is home to more than 2,400 One-horned Rhinoceroses, making it a critical area for their conservation.

### GIR NATIONAL PARK



Declared as National Park: **1975**



State: **Gujarat (Junagadh District)**



History:

- **1965** – Declared as Wildlife Sanctuary
- **1975** – Granted National Park status



Key Features:

- It is the only natural habitat of the Asiatic Lion in the world.
- It supports diverse wildlife in a dry deciduous forest ecosystem.



Other Important Facts:

- It was established in 1965.
- Supports a wide range of flora and fauna in a dry deciduous forest ecosystem.
- Plays a vital role in the conservation of the Asiatic Lion.

### KANHA NATIONAL PARK



Declared as National Park: **1955**



State: **Madhya Pradesh**  
(Mandla & Ballaghat Districts)



History:

- **1933** – Started as a Wildlife Sanctuary
- **1955** – Declared as National Park
- **1973** – Declared a Tiger Reserve under Project Tiger



Key Features:

- Kanha National Park, located in Madhya Pradesh, is famous for the Royal Bengal Tiger and Barasingha (Swamp Deer).
- It is a renowned Tiger Reserve and plays a significant role in tiger conservation.
- Established in 1955, it is one of the best managed and well-maintained national parks in India.

## TIMOR-LESTE : KEY FACTS & INFORMATION



### GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION

- **Location:** Between Southeast Asia and the South Pacific
- Timor Island is the largest island in the Lesser Sunda Islands, within the Malay Archipelago.
- **Boundaries:**
  - **North:** Banda Sea, Ombai Strait and Wetar Strait
  - **South:** Timor Sea
  - **West:** Land border with Indonesia (West Timor)
  - **Southern Neighbor:** Australia (across the Timor Sea)



### ABOUT THE COUNTRY

- **Official Name:** Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste
- **Other Name:** East Timor
- **Capital & Largest City:** Dili (located on the north coast of Timor)
- **Total Area:** 15,007 sq km (5,794 sq mi)



### GEOGRAPHICAL STRUCTURE

The country consists of:

1. The eastern part of Timor Island
2. The coastal enclave of Oecusse (located in the north-west of the island)
3. Atauro Island
4. Jaco Island



### POPULATION & CULTURE

- Over time, various Papuan and Austronesian peoples settled in Timor.
- This led to a diverse blend of cultures and languages linked to Southeast Asia and Melanesia.
- **Official Languages:** Tetum (national), Portuguese (official working language), Indonesian.
- **Major Religion:** Roman Catholicism (majority), along with traditional beliefs.



### HISTORICAL TIMELINE

- **16th Century:** East Timor came under Portuguese influence.
- **16th Century – 1975:** Remained a Portuguese colony.
- **1941:** During World War II, Allied forces occupied Dili.
- **1942:** Japanese took control until the end of the war (1945).
- **1975:** Portugal withdrew and a civil war began.
- **1999:** UN-sponsored referendum held; people voted for independence.
- **20 May 2002:** Timor-Leste became the first new sovereign state of the 21st century.
- **27 September 2002:** Timor-Leste became a member state of the United Nations.
- **2026:** Timor-Leste participated for the first time as a full member in the ASEAN Summit held in the Philippines.

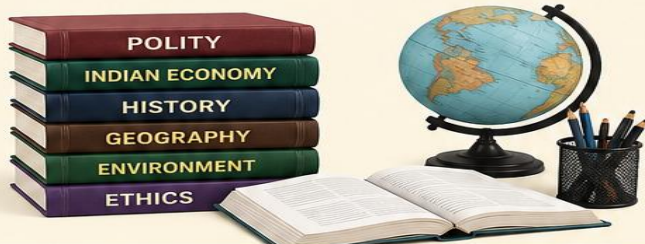
